

## CORPORATE OFFICE SPACE

The existing building was an open office environment with several cubicles placed around a center core. The client wanted to have a closed office setting for privacy and for concealing electronic equipment. A floor to ceiling movable partition was chosen to provide privacy and give the versatility to reconfigure in the future. The selection of wood finishes gives the new environment a sense of richness that helps both visitors and employees to relax. The wood panels were topped off with glass panels to give a feeling of openness while maintaining acoustical separation. The desk, walls and reception station are all freestanding which makes the entire space reconfigurable. Included in the furniture selection process was the need for an ergonomic work environment; the people who work here spend all day sitting at computers. Through the use of articulating keyboard trays and adjustable ergonomic seating, each work space can be fitted for anyone who uses it. Storage issues were addressed with the use of overhead storage bins, bookshelves, under-desk drawers and filing. With the addition of the new offices, each employee now has more work space and is less distracted which promotes productivity.
